I/We also authorize the Red Raiders to keep copies of information provided to it in both paper and electronic form. I/We know that participation in wrestling may result in serious injury. I on behalf of myself, the wrestler, the wrestler's family, executors, heirs and administrators do hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify and agree to hold harmless the Jr. Red Raiders Wrestling Club, the organizers, sponsors, supervisors, participants and persons transporting my/our child to and from activities for any claim arising out of any injury to my/our child, whether the result of negligence or for any other cause, except to the extent and in the amount covered by accident or liability insurance.

I/We agree to return upon request the uniform and other equipment issued to my/our child in as good a condition as when it was received except for normal wear and tear, and within the timeframes established by the Jr. Red Raiders Wrestling Club,. I/we understand and agree that failure to do so may result in the forfeiture of the equipment deposit amount of \$75.00 and does not exempt us from the requirement to return the equipment to the Jr. Red Raiders Wrestling Club.

Minor Waiver/Release of Liability

Regarding my minor child/ward being allowed to participate in the Red Raiders Youth Wrestling Program, I agree to this release of liability for he/she to participate in any way in the Red Raiders Youth Wrestling Program (herein also referred to as the "Red Raiders") program, related events and activities of the Red Raiders. The undersigned acknowledges, appreciates, and agrees that:

1. The risk of injury to my child from the activities involved in these programs is significant, including the potential for permanent disability and death, and while particular rules, equipment and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of injury does exist; and,
2. FOR MYSELF, SPOUSE, AND CHILD, I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, BOTH KNOWN AND UNKNOWN, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERS, AND ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR MY CHILD, and,
3. I willingly agree to comply with the program participation. If I observe any unusual significant concern in my child, in the program itself, I will remove my child from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately; and,
4. I, for myself, my spouse, my child and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE the Red Raiders Youth Wrestling Program, its directors, officers, volunteers, and other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and, if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event (herein collectively referred to herein as the "Released Parties") from any and all liability whatsoever, WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH OR OTHER DETRIMENTAL EVENT ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE AND/OR WILFUL ACTS OF THE RELEASED PARTIES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

I, for myself, my spouse, my child and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS all the above Released Parties from any and all liabilities incident to my or my child's/ward's involvement or participation in these programs, EVEN ARISING FROM THEIR NEGLIGENCE OR WILFUL ACTS, to the fullest extent permitted by law.



Parent and Participant Code of Conduct for 2009 2010

This code of conduct was developed to insure an environment that encourages good behavior, fair play, respect and fun. The Red Raiders Wrestling Club requires all parents and participants to support and actively practice this code of conduct. Under this code of conduct, parents and participants shall:

1. **Play Fair.** Fair play means respect. Winning is without value if victory has been achieved unfairly or dishonestly. Cheating is easy but brings no pleasure in the game. Playing fair requires courage, character and is always more satisfying. Fair play always has its rewards, even when the match is lost. Playing fair earns you respect, while cheaters are detested. Remember, it is only a wrestling match and would be pointless unless played fairly.
2. **Observe the Rules of the Sport:** All sports need rules to guide them. Without rules, there would be chaos. The rules of wrestling are simple and easy to learn. Make an effort to learn them so you can better understand the sport better. They are designated to make the sport fun to play and fun to watch.
3. **Respect Opponents, Teammates, Referees, Volunteer Coaches, Board members and Spectators.** These people have the same rights as you, including the right to be respected and are also a part of the sport. Without opponents there can be no sport. Do not criticize wrestlers, and opposing team or its wrestlers, coaches or fans by word of mouth, gestures or physical contact. Any criticism should be done later in private. Spectators give the sport atmosphere. They want to see the sport played fairly but must also behave fairly themselves. As a parent, I agree to not be on the wrestling mat, not to criticize officials, coaches, wrestlers or opposing wrestlers. I also agree to not physically touch any opposing team members or Red Raiders' team members, coaches or board members.
4. **No Criticizing of Referees or Officials.** Referees and officials are there to maintain discipline and fair play. Accept decisions made by officials as being fair and made to the best of their ability. Wrestlers and coaches must accept responsibility for their own actions and behavior.
5. **Play to Win:** Winning is the object in any sport. Never set out to lose. If you set out to lose you are cheating your opponents and yourself. Never give up against a stronger opponent and never relent against a weaker opponent. It is an insult to any opponent to wrestle less than 100%.
6. **Accept Defeat with Dignity.** Nobody wins all the time! You win some, and you lose some. Learn to lose graciously. Don't seek excuses for defeat, genuine reasons will always be self evident. Congratulate the winners with good grace. Don't blame the referee or official or anyone else. Decide to do and be better next time!
7. **Observe the Rules and Restrictions of the Locations where we compete.** Please refrain from use of tobacco, alcohol or illegal substances at all Red Raiders matches or practices. Avoid those things that impair you ability to make good judgments in the things that you do.
